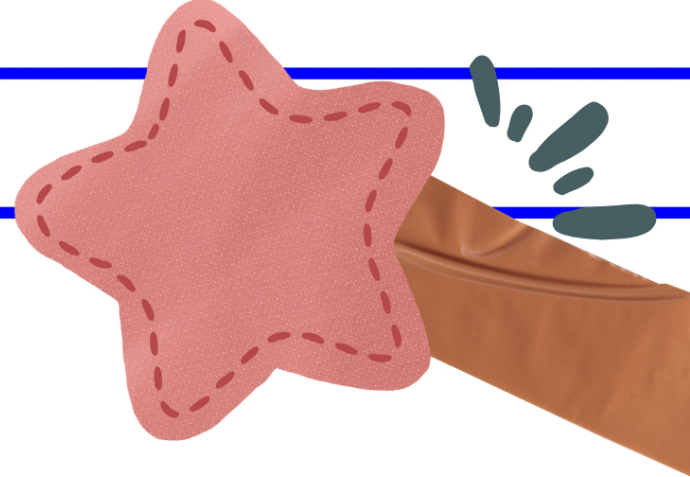




me and you are we
